

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of January, 1963, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council adopted Ordinance No. 47 establishing a Housing Authority on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Legal Department for the Public Housing Administration has in connection with the establishing of (Aided Self-Help Housing Program), requested certain revisions be made in Ordinance No. 47.

BE IT RESOLVED in meeting assembled this 7th day of March 1963, that Article III item e (2) be amended to insert between the words, "Provide" and "decent" the following:

" , or assist in providing (by any suitable method, including but not limited to: rental; sale of individual units in single or multifamily structures under conventional, condominium, or cooperative sales contracts; lease-purchase agreements; loans; or subsidizing of rentals or charges),"

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Article V, Section 1 i shall be amended

"i. To lease, rent, sell, or lease with option to purchase, any dwellings, accommodations, lands, buildings or facilities embraced within any project; to establish and revise rents, and to make rules and regulations concerning the occupancy, rental, care and management of its low-rent housing units. Such rules and regulations may establish priorities for the admission of tenants, and provide for the eviction of tenants for failure to pay rent, for failure to maintain the premises in satisfactory condition.

"The Board shall insure that dwelling accommodations in a housing project shall be made available only to families of low income at rentals within their financial reach by (A) establishing lower than average rentals for especially needy families, and (B) by establishing income limits for admission and continued occupancy by low income families. In making these determinations, the Board may take into consideration family size, composition, age, physical handicaps or other factors which might affect the financial ability of the family to pay rental and shall consider as well such economic factors as may affect the financial stability and solvency of the project."

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (m) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
