

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Canyon Day tribally-owned Police Station and Quarters required the installation of a bathroom therein, and

WHEREAS, sufficient savings in other accounts of the Law and Order Budget can be effectuated to cover the acquisition and installation costs of the bathroom.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$800.00 is to be paid to the White Mountain Tribal Construction and Maintenance Department by the Tribal Treasurer for the acquisition and installation of a bathroom at the tribally-owned Police Station and Quarters at Canyon Day, said sum to be secured by effectuating savings within the Law and Order Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Treasurer is hereby directed to effectuate \$800.00 savings under Section 3, of the Tribal Budget (Law and Order) with the approval of the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
