

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, because of the phenomenal increased public activities of the White Mountain Apache Tribe it has been necessary for the Tribal Chairman and Committee members to travel more than was anticipated when the Tribal Budget was first drafted, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe receives economic benefits by the said travel, and

WHEREAS, the said increased public activity automatically increases the Chairman's telephone and telegraph expenses, and

WHEREAS, because of the efficient management of the Public Relations Program there can be effectuated a savings of \$1890.00 in Section 1 of TR-62-40 (Public Relations).

BE IT RESOLVED that the following listed sums be transferred from Section 1 of the Tribal Budget as provided in TR 62-40 to the respective budget sections:

\$660.00 from 63-23 to 63-6
\$330.00 from 63-23 to 63-13
\$900.00 from 63-23 to 63-2

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
