FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Section II (h) of TR 62-40 provided \$800.00 for a Commercial Audit of the Tribal Treasurer, and

WHEREAS, while engaged in such audit, the Accounting Firm of Dennis, Parker & Schmich were also asked to conduct a property valuation survey in addition to their audit, and


WHEREAS, their bill for the total services rendered amounts to \$2,782.07 which is deemed just and reasonable for the services rendered.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Treasurer is directed to pay this bill from such savings as he, with the approval of the Council Chairman, be able to make in Tribal Budget TR 62-40.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
