

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Department has requested the Tribe to have free use of cinders on the reservation for the maintenance of roads thereon, and

WHEREAS, the said Highway Department has agreed subject to certain conditions to assign and maintain the Hawley Lake Road, and

WHEREAS, this will effectuate a great service to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to grant to the said Arizona Highway Department cinders from the reservation pits at no charge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of said cinders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said contract shall not extend for more than one year from the date hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
