

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Navopache Electric Co-operative, Inc., has requested permission to survey and construct a power distribution line from the new sawmill to Fort Apache, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 62-89 granted permission to Navopache Electric Co-operative, Inc., to construct a power distribution line covering the said line, and

WHEREAS, this line was constructed but later found to create a hazard near the Whiteriver landing strip.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Navopache Electric Co-operative, Inc., be authorized to make a survey and construct a power distribution line and that the Superintendent be authorized to issue a right of way in accordance with their application and maps that are on file in the office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all damages be waived as the Tribe will benefit by the survey and construction of the power distribution line.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
