

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney's Contract provides, among other things, that the Tribal Attorney is allowed for travel, telephone and other necessary expenses appertaining to his position as Tribal Attorney in the amount not to exceed \$2400.00, and

WHEREAS, the said contract further provides that the Tribal Attorney be allowed the sum of \$900.00 additional attorney's compensation for rendering extra legal services, and

WHEREAS, because of the increased workload of the Tribal Attorney, due to the expanding business activities of the Tribe, the Tribal Attorney's expenses have thereby increased.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney's expense account is hereby increased by the sum of \$500.00 i.e. from \$2400.00 to \$2900.00 is approved and authorized for the balance of the fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Treasurer effectuate a savings of \$500.00 from the extra legal compensation of \$900.00 authorized in the said Tribal Attorney's Contract.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
