

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, certain individual Indians are burying deceased persons in their yards and in other non-designated burial places, and

WHEREAS, this practice is not conducive to pleasant atmosphere on reservation lands.

BE IT RESOLVED that hereafter deceased persons will be buried in designated and established burial grounds on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
