WHEREAS, certain Indian students from other reservations are attending the Theodore Roosevelt Boarding School, and

WHEREAS, during the school year many groups of children from the said Theodore Roosevelt Boarding School go on fishing excursions, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to make the educational environment of non-Apache Indian students more enjoyable.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Recreation Manager is hereby authorized and directed to issue to non-Apache Indian students attending Theodore Roosevelt Boarding School free tribal fishing permits when sufficient students are organized and chaperoned as a group.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
