

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company Sawmill-Planing Mill is now near completion, and

WHEREAS, it is a good business practice to have the proposed manager of the sawmill-planing mill to be on the job during the shakedown period and for a short time previous thereto, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is the Interim Board of Directors of the Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, a great deal of study and work has been done by the Superintendent, the Tribal Attorney and the Tribal Chairman in locating the best qualified manager of the said sawmill at a salary within the financial means of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Raymond L. Jackson, of Bend, Oregon, has an educational background in both engineering and forestry and has had successful managing in a sawmill-planing mill of a yearly capacity in excess of one hundred thirty million board feet, and

WHEREAS, the said Raymond L. Jackson has made application for the position of General Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company Sawmill-Planing Mill.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council acting in its capacity as the Interim Board of Directors of the Fort Apache Timber Company and in its further capacity as the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Raymond L. Jackson be hereby employed, effective June 1, 1963, as the General Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company at an annual salary of \$18,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney prepare for the Chairman and Secretary's signatures, an employment contract with the said Raymond L. Jackson.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from the Fort Apache Timber Company funds, a sum to fully pay the said salary together with all taxes and health and accident insurance costs.

The foregoing resolution was on May 17, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
