

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, surveys indicate that a harvestable surplus animals exist on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, it is beneficial to harvest these surplus animals in the interest of good game management and range protection, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Recreation Board has recommended that permits be issued to non-members to accomplish the elk harvest.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby authorized the issuance of reservation wide 200 bulls only permits for a hunt to be conducted September 27 through October 2, 1963 and the issuance of reservation wide 450 any elk permits for a hunt to be conducted November 16 through November 24, 1963.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
