

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Paul Ramsey and Sons has been awarded the Logging Contract with the Fort Apache Timber Company, said contract being for a period of three years and covering approximately sixty million board feet of timber, and


WHEREAS, the said Paul Ramsey and Sons desires to construct on the Fort Apache Timber Company Sawmill premises, a truck building, and


WHEREAS, it will be of benefit to the Tribe to have the logging trucks repaired inclose proximity to the sawmill operations.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to issue a revocable permit to Paul Ramsey and Sons for use as a truck repair and maintenance building.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent are further authorized to ascertain the needed amount of lands, any rentals, lease and location thereof.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
