


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Maverick Logging Unit, Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., purchaser, has quarterly stumpage price adjustments for the various species based on the Western Pine Association lumber index prices which are published monthly, and
- WHEREAS, the Association has discontinued the 1953-1954 basis index for Engelmann spruce and has substituted the new 1959-60-61 basis index for this specie, and
- WHEREAS, the Assistant Area Director has determined that the 1959-60-61 index will adequately reflect the trend of spruce lumber sales prices.
- BE IT RESOLVED that beginning July 1, 1963 Engelmann spruce quarterly stumpage price adjustments for this logging unit will be based on the second quarter 1963 stumpage rate of \$3.31 per thousand board feet B. M. and the aritmetical average Engelmann spruce lumber index price (1959-60-61 basis) of \$71.85 for the months of January, February and March, 1963.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
