

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Recreation Board has reviewed the salaries of the Game Wardens employed by the Recreation Enterprise and found them to be inadequate, and

WHEREAS, the Board has recommended that the Recreation Enterprise Budget be amended to provide for salary increases to become effective July 1, 1963, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 62-130 authorizes an increase of twenty percent in any specific item of the Enterprise Budget, provided that savings are accrued from other items in the budget.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Recreation Enterprise Manager is authorized to increase Item 1 (d), Page 31 of the approved Enterprise Budget, from \$8,000.00 to \$9,000.00 and Item 1 (g) from \$3,500.00 to \$3,650.00 to provide for the salary increases.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
