

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe receives numerous benefits from the operation of the Williams Creek Federal Fish Hatchery, and

WHEREAS, there has been a long standing agreement between the Tribe and the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service for the operation of the Hatchery, and


WHEREAS, under the agreement, the Tribe has furnished salaries for two full time Apache Indians employed at the Hatchery, and

WHEREAS, funds for the continuation of the agreement were not included in the Tribal Budget for the 1963-64 Fiscal Year.

BE IT RESOLVED that Section VIII of the 1963-64 Fiscal Year Tribal Budget be amended to provide \$7,702.00 for the continuation of the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery support program.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
