

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is an unchartered organization operating under the Indian Re-organization Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended by the Act of June 15, 1935 (4 Stat. 378) and operating under the provision of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958 and adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribal voters June 27, 1958, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona, is desirous of improving the social and economic well being of its people, and

WHEREAS, to accomplish this objective a cadastral survey is needed as well as a comprehensive oil, gas, water and mineral survey, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe does not have the financial means to accomplish these objectives, and

WHEREAS, the United States Geological Survey, Bureau of Land Management, and the Bureau of Mines, and other agencies are qualified, have the means and are the proper agencies to conduct this work.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Secretary of the Tribal Council are hereby authorized and directed to request the Secretary of the Interior and our congressional delegation to provide the funds and to direct the appropriate agencies of the Federal Government to consummate the said cadastral and mineral survey.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to our congressional delegation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
