

Resolution of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Trustee in Bankruptcy of the Patterson Estate has offered to sell the Tribe approximately three hundred chairs and a movie sound projector for the sum of \$2500.00, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the purchase of said items could be used by the Tribe to provide movies for tribal members.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Purchasing Agent, the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the Recreation Manager are hereby authorized to investigate and if they are of the opinion that it is economically feasible, to purchase the said movie equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Government, the sum of \$2500.00 the cost of the purchase of said equipment.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
