

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, due to the many discrepancies in the descriptions of lands occupied by the Whiteriver Elementary School and Alchesay High School, Whiteriver, Arizona.

WHEREAS, there have been numerous revocable permits issued and descriptions made to cover these school sites.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to execute twenty five year gratuitous leases with an option to renew for an additional period of twenty five years with the Board of Trustees of Elementary School District No. 20 and Alchesay High School as described on the maps on file in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency to which reference is hereby made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the leases be terminated for any cause that all improvements, buildings or other properties placed upon the leased ground shall belong and revert to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions and permits previously enacted pertaining to the above school sites are hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (e) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
