

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney's Contract expires on August 9, 1963, and

WHEREAS, Barry DeRose, Tribal Attorney, has performed good and faithful service for the White Mountain Apache Tribe and in many cases in excess of his present contract.

WHEREAS, the present enterprises and the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe have progressed with the advice and guidance of Barry DeRose, and

WHEREAS, the growth of old enterprises and the establishment of new enterprises have increased the working load of the Tribal Attorney within the past few months.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and Superintendent draft a new contract for a term of five years with the advice and guidance of the Department of the Interior Field Solicitor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the new contract shall require the services of the Tribal Attorney of not less than twelve days per month at a salary of \$1,000.00 per month.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this contract.

The foregoing resolution was on July 31, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
