

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Western States Telephone Company, Inc., with office and principal place of business at Holbrook, Arizona, has requested a right of way for telephone lines from the White Mountain Apache Tribe twenty feet in width and 8.847 miles in length across Indian trust lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Apache County, State of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe will benefit by the construction of said telephone lines in the Smith Park area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a right of way twenty feet in width and 8.847 miles in length as described and delineated on Maps No. 1 through 3, which are on file in the office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Agency, is hereby granted to the Western States Telephone Company, inc., and that the Chairman of the Tribal Council be authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate said right of way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all damages be waived as the Tribe will benefit by the construction of the telephone line.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right of way is granted subject to the conditions outlined in Resolution No. 62-18 adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe on March 7, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Western States Telephone Company, Inc., is required to effectuate a joint use agreement with Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., so that no additional telephone poles will be installed in any area now being served by the said Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
