FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, necessity has caused a policeman to be installed at Hawley Lake, and that the available radios are already in use, and

WHEREAS, there remains a savings in the FY 1963-64 Budget account for the purchase of four new police trucks, due to refund of excise tax.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$800.00 in savings from purchase of police trucks be transferred to an account to purchase a new police band radio for installation in the Hawley Lake vehicle.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
