

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to maintain an effective game management program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and to provide the maximum opportunity to tribal members to harvest surplus game animals, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is charged with the responsibility of administering the game management program and making recommendations to the Tribal Council for the setting of game seasons and bag limits, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise has presented its recommendations to the Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached tribal hunting regulations be adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council for the 1963-64 seasons.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
