

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there has been a tremendous increase in the use of the facilities operated by the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise at Hawley Lake, and
- WHEREAS, revenue is being lost because of lack of accommodations to adequately serve the customers in the area, and
- WHEREAS, expected loan funds for expansion of lodging facilities, office space and commercial buildings has not materialized, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise has adequate cash on hand to capitalize certain improvements to meet a portion of the immediate needs.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the 1963 White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Budget be amended to permit capital expenditures of Enterprise funds in the amount of \$30,000.00 to construct six rental cabins and make certain additions to the Hawley Lake store and office building.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
