FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Stanley Wright has been employed by the White Mountain Apache Tribe as Manager of the Tribal Herd Enterprise for a number of years, and


WHEREAS, the said Stanley Wright has carried out his work beyond and above the call of duty.

BE IT RESOLVED that Stanley Wright is hereby granted tribal hunting and fishing privileges for a period of five years or until he is no longer employed by the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council reserves the right to revoke the said hunting and fishing privileges at any time without cause.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
