

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the loan agreements with the borrowers under the Self-Help Housing Program stipulate monthly payments to start one month after completion of the house, and

WHEREAS, it is normal procedure to charge and accrue interest from the date of advance of loan funds to the borrowers.

BE IT RESOLVED that the date of the final inspection of the houses in the East Fork-Canyon Day Self-Help Home Builders project listed below be construed to be the date of "advance of loan funds"
