
WHEREAS, this would be a great honor and privilege.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to furnish to the President of the United States a Christmas Tree to be used at the annual Christmas Party of the said President in Washington, D. C.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
