

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a dire need for improving the airport near Whiteriver, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, Charles Montgomery has offered to construct a hangar on said airport, and

WHEREAS, the said hangar is badly needed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to execute a five year lease with a five year option on a parcel of land on the airport approximately 40' x 30' to be used as a hangar by Mr. Charles Montgomery.

BE IT RESOLVED that rental for said lease be at the appraised value of said land.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Charles Montgomery present to the Chairman and Superintendent for their approval a metes and bounds description and plot of said area of ground to be leased.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
