

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, James D. Sparks, Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, has proven himself to be an outstanding Recreation Director and Supervisor of the Fish and Wildlife on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, he has trained many Apaches to become self-sufficient, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to show its appreciation to the said James D. Sparks.

BE IT RESOLVED that James D. Sparks is hereby granted Tribal Hunting and fishing privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for three year period and during the term of his contract.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
