

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is imperative that logging operations in the West Block of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation be continued, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to open for a new area in order to effectuate this continuance.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Jump Off No. 2 Logging Unit be appraised for the continuance of logging operations in the West Block of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
