

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe has been advised that Mount Ord would make an excellent ski run and winter sports area, and

WHEREAS, a number of persons have shown interest in leasing said area, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, if financing can be secured, would be interested in developing said area, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make a complete study of the area in order to justify the development by the Tribe or in leasing same.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau is hereby requested to make a feasibility study of the Mount Ord area to determine, among other things, the justification for the expenditure of funds for the development of a ski run and winter sports area.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
