

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Board Directors of the Fort Apache Timber Company has recommended the purchase of a Gerlinger Carrier to expedite removal of lumber from the green chain, and

WHEREAS, funds have not been previously budgeted for the purchase of a Gerlinger Carrier, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Fort Apache Timber Company has directed the Acting Manager to rebuild the green chain which is considered a major bottleneck in the new sawmill.

BE IT RESOLVED that the amount of \$12,500.00 is hereby approved for the purchase of a Gerlinger Carrier, 12,000 pounds capacity and the Fort Apache Timber Company Budget for six months operation as amended is, to effectuate said purchase, hereby approved.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
