

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Council Resolution No. 62-129 on December 7, 1962, approved homesite leases for nineteen applicants for tribal loans, and

WHEREAS, this resolution provided that such leases would automatically terminate in cases where the related loans were not approved within ninety days of December 7, 1962, and

WHEREAS, the lease of Dennis and Nellie Massey was included on Resolution No. 62-129 and their loan was approved after the ninety-day period had elapsed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the homesite lease of Dennis and Nellie Massey approved by Resolution No. 62-129 is hereby reapproved subject to and to become effective upon the date of the final approval of the loan to construct a home.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
