FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Editorial Director of the Apache Scout has underestimated the amount of money needed to operate the newspaper under miscellaneous expenses, and

WHEREAS, he has overestimated the amount of money needed for costs of the publication of the scout.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$600.00 be transferred from 64-77 and added to 64-78.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that he be allowed to pay ten percent (10%) commission to the Recreation Enterprise for all advertisements turned in by the Enterprise Manager.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
