

Resolution of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Tribal Council to promote the use of Tribal members as hunting guides on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors has recommended that uniform guide regulations be established as an aid to game law enforcement.

BE IT RESOLVED that all Tribal member guides taking hunting parties on the reservation be required to obtain a free guide permit from the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise and adhere to such regulations as are established by the Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors. Said regulations being subject to the approval of the Tribal Council and on file in the Tribal Council Offices.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1963 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
