

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Jump Off No. 2 Logging Unit is nearing completion, and

WHEREAS, the harvesting of the timber and the sawing of same by the Reidhead-Chlarson Lumber Company Sawmill located in the town of Carrizo is the only industry supporting said town.

WHEREAS, the Deer Springs Logging Unit which is adjacent to Jump Off No. 2 Logging Unit will not be ready for bids until December, 1964 at which time logging is impossible due to severe winter weather conditions and which will cause severe unemployment in the town of Carrizo, and

WHEREAS, the Reidhead Lumber Company, Inc. has an active contract for the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit, the logs from which are required to be cut at the new Reidhead-Chlarson Lumber Company, Inc. Sawmill at Cibecue which is now under construction and will not be completed until April, 1965, and


WHEREAS, logs from Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit could be hauled to the Carrizo mill during the favorable weather in October and November, thus relieving the impending unemployment at the town of Carrizo.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit Contract be amended to permit not to exceed four million board feet to be hauled from Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit to the Company mill at Carrizo, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this logging operation shall in no way decelerate the construction progress on the sawmill now being built at Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
