

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is no cocktail lounge where Indian people can gather socially,
and

WHEREAS, they must travel 22 miles to the nearest location, and


WHEREAS, a snack bar canteen type project on the reservation would be economic-
ally feasible.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit in the
U. S. Treasury the sum of \$25,160.00 for the construction of a snack
bar canteen building.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby directed to appoint an
advisory committee to secure the most feasible location for said canteen.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon completion of said canteen the same be leased
to the Recreation Enterprise for its operation and a rental to be agreed
upon by the Chairman, Superintendent and the Recreation Board.

The foregoing resolution was on October 1, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9
for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
