WHEREAS, Resolution No. 64-54, May 27, 1964, approved a cutting plan for Reservation timber on an annual basis, and


WHEREAS, the Area Director has requested a more detailed program of sales to be advertised for bids through the year, 1969.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached program dated September 2, 1964, be available for distribution to interested timber purchasers.

The foregoing resolution was on October 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
