

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit contract approved August 14, 1964, Reidhead and Chlarson Lumber Company, Inc. Purchaser, stipulates that eight million board feet of timber will be cut on or before December 31, 1964, and

WHEREAS, said timber is to be cut by a new sawmill being constructed at Cibecue which will not be operating until April, 1965, this volume cannot be milled as specified by the contract.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Purchaser be excused from the cutting obligation stated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Purchaser be required to cut, not to exceed four million, provided the Commissioner approves the amendment to the purchasing contract prior to April 30, 1965, to be milled at Carrizo.

The foregoing resolution was on October 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
