

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is an unchartered organization operating under the Indian Re-organization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended by the Act of June 15, 1935 (49 Stat. 378) and operating under the provisions of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958 and adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribal voters June 27, 1958, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is authorized to borrow money and to pledge future tribal income under the provisions of Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws, and

WHEREAS, Contract 14-20-450-3804 with the United States government according to the loan agreement will automatically expire January 1, 1965, and

WHEREAS, there still remains an unadvanced amount under said contract of \$1,637,080, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe still has a need for these funds when available.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby requests that Section 2 of the loan contract be extended to January 1, 1967, and approves the Modification #5 of Contract 14-20-450-3804, proposed projects amounts, dates and justification.

The foregoing resolution was on October 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
