

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has appointed a White Mountain Tribal Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Tribal Housing Authority has been allocated 150 homes by the Public Housing Administration to be built on the mutual aid concept, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Housing Authority to lease lands which will be subsequently leased to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the first development selected by the Housing Authority will be known as the Diamond Creek Turn-off Housing Development.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the area known as the Diamond Creek Turn-off Housing Development be leased to the White Mountain Tribal Housing Authority for a term of 25 years with a 25-year option with a waiver of lease fees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby waives the right of approval of all leases and occupancy agreements executed in favor of members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by the Housing Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on October 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
