

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Gordon W. Boudreau of the Bio-Sonics Control Company, 4236 East Turney, Phoenix, Arizona has requested permission to conduct research in the control of pest birds on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, all birds or animals trapped during the research project will be released unharmed at the descretion of the Tribal Wildlife representatives, and

WHEREAS, copies of reports or findings of interest to the Tribal Council will be made available without charge by the Bio-Sonics Control Company, and

WHEREAS, this project is considered to be of value to the Tribe in its wild-life management program.

BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Gordon W. Boudreau be issued a permit to conduct research on the reservation for a period of three years beginning January 1, 1965.

The foregoing resolution was on October 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
