FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the North Fork Oak Logging Unit begun in 1958 has sold oak converter poles by units of approximately 1,000 cords, the last unit being No. 6, and

BE IT RESOLVED that North Fork Oak No. 7 Logging Unit, of 1,000 cords be prepared for advertisement according to regulations under the following conditions:


- (a) That the approved stumpage rate of \$3.50 per cord as recommended by the Area Forester November 10, 1964 be approved;
- (b) That the contract be approved subject to such changes as may be deemed necessary by the Area Director and concurred in by the Council Chairman;
- (c) That the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to execute the contract and any necessary extensions or modifications for and in behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the net proceeds from the sale of this timber be deposited to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
