WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that 34 members of the Tribe work at the Reidhead mill in Show Low, and


WHEREAS, these members have worked and lived in Show Low for many years, some of them owning homes, and

WHEREAS, elimination of off reservation bidders could lower the stumpage prices received.


BE IT RESOLVED that each timber sale will be considered by the Council on its own merits as to whether or not the Council will require logs to be sawed in sawmills on the reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 64-106 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
