

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians is an outstanding organization, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apaches should become a part of the Organization.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe become members of the National Congress of American Indians.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the dues of \$162.38 for the year, 1964, be paid from Public Relations Fund.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
