

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Highway from Whiteriver to the Fort Apache Timber Company has not been named, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that said road be named so that customers can locate the main office of the Fort Apache Timber Company.

BE IT RESOLVED that the road from the junction of State Highway 73 in Whiteriver, Arizona to the Fort Apache Timber Company cut off is hereby designated and named as the Fort Apache Timber Company Road.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
