

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Shirley and Bowman Daley, husband and wife, have applied for loans from the Revolving Credit Fund for home construction, and

WHEREAS, homesite lease is required by Section 23 (c) II of the Declaration of Policy and Plan of Operation approved September 18, 1963 and by Tribal Ordinance No. 44, and

WHEREAS, June Massey has offered in writing to relinquish the following described portion of her land assignment to Shirley Daley, her granddaughter: Located in the East Fork-Seven Mile Community in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29; T5N, R23E, a rectangular plot 161 feet east and west by 100 feet north and south and located as follows: Beginning at the REA power pole directly across from the East Fork Trading Post, and counting it #1, travel down the road in a westerly direction to pole #6; thence 175.0 feet south to the northeast corner of the above plot, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has no objection to the use of the land by Mr. and Mrs. Daley.

BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe do hereby approve the partial relinquishment of June Massey's assignment No. 7, such portion relinquished being described as a rectangular plot 161 feet east and west by 100 feet north and south situated in the East Fork-Seven Mile Community, in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, T5N, R23E.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council grants a homesite lease to Shirley and Bowman Daley for a period of 25 years at a rate of \$12.00 per year payable in advance on the first day of the month following the effective date of the lease, with an annual payment in a like amount on the same date each year thereafter in accordance with the terms of the lease for as long as the lease shall run.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall execute said lease for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in accordance with Tribal Ordinance No. 44; the effective date of the commencement of said lease being the date of the approval of the loan by the Secretary of the Interior or his designated representative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the loan not be approved in (120) one hundred twenty days from the date hereof, the lease shall thereby automatically terminate.
