

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. has requested permission to survey and construct powerline extensions within the Cibecue community to supply power to domestic water pumps as requested by the U. S. Public Health Service, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe will benefit by the construction of said powerline extensions within the Cibecue community.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. is hereby granted permission to make surveys for the powerline extensions.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council consents and hereby grants permission to the Superintendent to grant a right of way, 20 feet in width, and 0.998 miles in length to the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., pursuant to the official plat of said area on file in the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, for a period of not to exceed 20 years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all damages be waived because of the beneficial results that will ensue by the survey and construction of the powerline.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
