

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, one adding machine and one printing calculator are old and becoming unreliable and in need of frequent repair, and

WHEREAS, due to general tribal business expansion, the need exists for almost constant use of these machines in the Tribal Business Office, and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be economically prudent to replace these old office machines with new equipment, and

WHEREAS, a savings exists in the business office budget due to economies in use of personnel.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$950.00 be transferred from FY 1963-64 Budget Resolution Account 64-38 to Account 64-43 to cover the cost of a new Friden adding machine and a new Monroe printing calculator.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
