


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that our Tribal Attorney, Barry DeRose is being considered by the Governor to be appointed as a Member at Large of the Employment Security Commission of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that not only the Indian people, but the entire State of Arizona would benefit by such an appointment.

BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that Governor Sam Goddard be urged to appoint Mr. Barry DeRose as a Member at Large of the Employment Security Commission of Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
