

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Terry Reidhead of the Reidhead Sand and Rock Company, Taylor, Arizona desires to obtain cinders from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, it is economically beneficial to the Tribe to sell cinders.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Reidhead Sand and Rock Company be authorized to remove 7,800 cubic yards of cinders from the McNary Cinder Pit at a rate of twenty five (25) cents per cubic yard.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Terry Reidhead be held responsible to see that the gate to the said cinder pit be locked at all times when the pit is not in use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all employees of the Reidhead Sand and Rock Company removing cinders from the McNary Cinder Pit check in at the Hon-dah Service Station in accordance with Resolution No. 63-78.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
